

Home Learning - Curriculum Enrichment - Reception

Please note that these tasks are optional tasks that you may wish to complete with your child at home that will enrich their curriculum experience.

Every term, there will be a Home Learning Exhibition, during which pupils can showcase their learning to the class and photos will be taken to put on the school website.

Term	Subject	Topic and Task suggestions:
Autumn (All About Me)	PSED	 Make a healthy meal with a grown-up. You could take a photo or draw and label what you ate. Think of a time when you were kind to someone else. You could take a photo, draw or write about it.
	Expressive Arts and Design	 Our Homes – can you create your home out of junk modelling materials? Bonfire Night – paint or draw a fireworks picture – you can use any materials you have available e.g., glitter, crayons, pencils etc. Create an Autumn collage using fallen leaves, twigs etc.
	Understanding The World	 Go on an Autumn hunt. Can you draw and label the signs of Autumn? Draw a map of your journey to school. Can you label the things you see on the way to school?
Spring (Animals)	English	• Create a fact file about your favourite animal or pet. What does it look like? Where does it live? What does it eat?
	Understanding the World	 Go on a Winter hunt. Can you draw and label the signs of Winter? Go on a minibeast hunt in your garden. You could take photos or draw and label the different minibeasts you find.
	Expressive Arts and Design	 Create an Easter Bonnet or design your own Easter egg. Create your favourite animal using junk modelling materials.
	Maths	 Go on a 2D shape hunt around your home. Take photos or draw and label the different shapes you find. Capacity - Take one container and fill it with water, rice or pasta. Can you find another container that would hold more? Can you find a container that would hold less? Can you put the containers in order? Take photos or draw a picture of your containers. Capacity - Create your own magic potion recipe by adding spoonfuls of different items (such as water, squash, honey or sugar) to a cup or bowl. Can you record your recipe and show the number of spoonfuls needed?
Summer (Journeys)	English	 Create a story map for the story of 'The Gingerbread Man' Bake a Gingerbread Man with a grownup. Can you write a list of the ingredients you used?
	Understanding the World	 Go on a Spring hunt. Can you draw and label the signs of Spring? Plant a seed and watch it grow. Take photos to record. What does it need to grow healthily? Pirates – draw a treasure map. Can you use symbols and a key? Where are your family from? Can you create a flag for that country?
	Expressive Arts and Design	 Create a mode of transport using junk modelling materials. It could be a rocket, a pirate ship, a car, an airplane etc. Create a picture of the planets using any materials you have at home.
	Maths	• Go on a 3D shape hunt around your home. Take photos or draw and label the different shapes you find.
