Term	Subject	Topic and Task suggestions:
Autumn (All About Me)	PSED	<ul> <li>Make a healthy meal with a grown-up. You could take a photo or draw and label what you ate.</li> <li>Think of a time when you were kind to someone else. You could take a photo, draw or write about it.</li> </ul>
	Expressive Arts and Design	<ul> <li>Our Homes – can you create your home out of junk modelling materials?</li> <li>Bonfire Night – paint or draw a fireworks picture – you can use any materials you have available e.g., glitter, crayons, pencils etc.</li> <li>Create an Autumn collage using fallen leaves, twigs etc.</li> </ul>
	Understanding The World	<ul> <li>Go on an Autumn hunt. Can you draw and label the signs of Autumn?</li> <li>Draw a map of your journey to school. Can you label the things you see on the way to school?</li> </ul>
Spring (Animals)	English	• Create a fact file about your favourite animal or pet. What does it look like? Where does it live? What does it eat?
	Understanding the World	<ul> <li>Go on a Winter hunt. Can you draw and label the signs of Winter?</li> <li>Go on a minibeast hunt in your garden. You could take photos or draw and label the different minibeasts you find.</li> </ul>
	Expressive Arts and Design	<ul> <li>Create an Easter Bonnet or design your own Easter egg.</li> <li>Create your favourite animal using junk modelling materials.</li> </ul>
	Maths	<ul> <li>Go on a 2D shape hunt around your home. Take photos or draw and label the different shapes you find.</li> <li>Capacity - Take one container and fill it with water, rice or pasta. Can you find another container that would hold more? Can you find a container that would hold less? Can you put the containers in order? Take photos or draw a picture of your containers.</li> <li>Capacity - Create your own magic potion recipe by adding spoonfuls of different items (such as water, squash, honey or sugar) to a cup or bowl. Can you record your recipe and show the number of spoonfuls needed?</li> </ul>
Summer (Journeys)	English	<ul> <li>Create a story map for the story of 'The Gingerbread Man'</li> <li>Bake a Gingerbread Man with a grownup. Can you write a list of the ingredients you used?</li> </ul>
	Understanding the World	<ul> <li>Go on a Spring hunt. Can you draw and label the signs of Spring?</li> <li>Plant a seed and watch it grow. Take photos to record. What does it need to grow healthily?</li> <li>Pirates – draw a treasure map. Can you use symbols and a key?</li> <li>Where are your family from? Can you create a flag for that country?</li> </ul>
	Expressive Arts and Design	<ul> <li>Create a mode of transport using junk modelling materials. It could be a rocket, a pirate ship, a car, an airplane etc.</li> <li>Create a picture of the planets using any materials you have at home.</li> </ul>
	Maths	• Go on a 3D shape hunt around your home. Take photos or draw and label the different shapes you find.
