Autumn	History – Ancient Greece	 Create a timeline of all the key events from Ancient Greek times Create a model of a Spartan solider Create an Ancient Greek theatre model Make a mask that could be used in Ancient Greek times
	Art – Drawing and painting	 Recreate one of Hundertwasser's paintings Create your own abstract landscape painting in the style of Hundertwasser Create a fact file about Hundertwasser
	Science – Properties and Changes of Materials	 Create your own 'kitchen disaster' and try to separate the materials. Make a kitchen recipe that involves an irreversible change e.g. a cake Make a reversible change using states of matter and create a poster on what you did.
Spring	RE – What is Holy Communion?	 Create a picture of the Last Supper Create a poster/picture/model of a group that you belong to Create a cross and decorate it
	Geography – Locate World Countries	 Make a model of the globe with latitude and longitude lines Make a model of the globe with its biomes marked Choose a biome and draw/paint a landscape from that biome
	History – Compare the Mayans and Anglo-Saxons	 Create a timeline of the significant events in the Mayan history Make a model of a Mayan city-state Make a poster to explain the Mayan numbers
