Our vision statement is:



	<b>Attendance &amp; Punctuality</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt; Care for your child's safety and happiness.</li> <li>&gt; Monitor your child's punctuality and attendance in line with their achievement, behaviour and wellbeing.</li> <li>&gt; Inform you when there are concerns about your child's attendance and punctuality.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt; Make sure my child attends school regularly and on time.</li> <li>&gt; Contact the school each day of my child's absence.</li> <li>&gt; Fully support the school Attendance Policy. Avoid taking holidays or days out during the school term. Seek authority from the Headteacher for any absences.</li> <li>&gt; Make arrangements for my child's safe journey to and from school and ensure that they are collected on time at the end of the day.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt; Arrive at school on time every day that I can, and be ready to learn.</li> </ul>
	<b>Uniform</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Offer a cost-effective, easily accessible school uniform which promotes a sense of pride community and belonging.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt; Make sure my child is dressed in the correct uniform and footwear and arrives in their PE kit to school when PE is timetabled.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt; Wear the correct school uniform and footwear.</li> <li>&gt; Wear the correct PE kit to school on PE days.</li> </ul>
	<b>Working together</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt; Communicate between home and school through accessible notices, newsletters, texts, email and the school website.</li> <li>&gt; Offer opportunities for parents and carers to get involved in school life.</li> <li>&gt; Respond to communications from parents and carers in a timely manner, following school policies.</li> <li>&gt; Keep you informed of your child's progress, learning and well-being, through meetings, learning consultations, parents' evenings and an annual written report.</li> <li>&gt; Contact you as soon as possible if we are concerned about your child's progress, behaviour, attendance or well-being.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt; Communicate to the school any concerns that I have about my child that may affect their behaviour in school or ability to learn.</li> <li>&gt; Read and follow the school's policies.</li> <li>&gt; Treat all members of the school community with care and respect.</li> <li>&gt; Read all communications sent home by the school and respond where necessary.</li> <li>&gt; Ensure that the school is informed immediately of any change to contact details.</li> <li>&gt; Attend learning consultations and discussions about my child's progress, achievement and social development.</li> <li>&gt; Reply to any school correspondence.</li> <li>&gt; Ensure that no negative, personal or adverse comments about children, staff or the school are posted on any social networks or websites, including Facebook.</li> <li>&gt; Be respectful and considerate towards all members of the school and the local community.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt; Ask for help if I need it.</li> <li>&gt; Let an adult know if I am feeling sad or worried.</li> </ul>

	<b>Effort</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Have the highest of expectations for your child.</li> <li>➤ Provide a broad and balanced curriculum that caters for all children.</li> <li>➤ Offer your child opportunities to develop a sense of responsibility, form healthy social relationships and build their self-esteem.</li> <li>➤ Offer a range of extra-curricular activities designed to enrich your child's school experience.</li> <li>➤ Enable your child to understand that success and achievement can come with effort.</li> <li>➤ Teach pupils the school's learner qualities so that they have the skills to be the best learner they can possibly be.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Encourage my child to try their best so they can reach their full potential.</li> <li>➤ Engage in parent meetings and work together with the school in order to achieve the best outcomes for my child.</li> <li>➤ Engage with termly reports and test scores, celebrating my child's successes with them and supporting them in areas they find difficult.</li> <li>➤ Help my child to be healthy in mind and body.</li> <li>➤ Help my child to understand that success and achievement can come with effort.</li> <li>➤ Support the Christian ethos of the school.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Try my best to do my work.</li> <li>➤ Look after any books or other school property.</li> <li>➤ Live out the school's values and try my best to show the school's learner qualities.</li> </ul>
	<b>Home learning</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Set regular homework in line with our home learning policy.</li> <li>➤ Provide feedback for home learning tasks.</li> <li>➤ Provide a space and time for pupils to complete home learning if they are unable to.</li> <li>➤ Provide key logins for electronic learning.</li> <li>➤ Provide home learning books and resources.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Make sure that my child completes their homework on time, in line with the school's home learning policy.</li> <li>➤ Raise any issues that my child has with home learning with their teachers.</li> <li>➤ Ensure that my child reads every night</li> <li>➤ Ensure my child's reading record is completed, signed and returned to school in year groups that request this.</li> <li>➤ Support my child in looking after home learning books and resources given by the school and ensure they return to school.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Do my homework and bring it back to school on time.</li> <li>➤ Look after any home learning books or resources and return them to school.</li> </ul>
	<b>Behaviour</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Promote high standards of behaviour so we can maintain a safe environment for all children.</li> <li>➤ Provide opportunities for pupils to develop leadership skills.</li> <li>➤ Teach St George's values so pupils know how to behave responsibly.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Support the school to make sure my child maintains a consistently high standard of behavior.</li> <li>➤ Notify school of concerns.</li> <li>➤ Deal with concerns through the school and not with other parents or pupils directly.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Be ready. Be respectful. Be safe.</li> <li>➤ Be friendly and caring towards other children and adults.</li> <li>➤ Listen to instructions from the adults at school and follow the school rules.</li> <li>➤ Look after the school equipment and be respectful of the school environment.</li> <li>➤ Behave appropriately on the way to and from school.</li> </ul>
